<b>Caucus participation (Moderated)</b> ___/10 points	Never or almost never tried to participate in moderated caucuses or participates negatively.	Spoke occasionally (2-4 times/session) during caucuses. Comments and questions are generally productive and accurate.	Spoke frequently during caucuses (more than 5 times/session) and significantly contributed to debate.

<b>Diplomacy and Cooperation (Unmoderated)</b> ___/10 points	Obviously not diplomatic; may be rude or aggressive (beyond the bounds of authenticity), or is not involved in resolution creation	Adequately diplomatic. Always diplomatic and uses diplomacy to foster cooperation, create solutions and bring countries together. Is a leader in the resolution creating process.
